## Appendix C

### Supplemental Appendix

This supplemental appendix provides detailed correspondences between the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) benchmark input-output (IO) tables at various aggregations and years and the 1987 4-digit Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes used in the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER)–Center for Economic Studies (CES) Manufacturing Industry Database (MID). The tables are also available in spreadsheet form (comma separated values) on the authors’ web sites.

We develop a correspondence between the 6-digit IO code–based IO data and the 4-digit SIC code–based MID data. The ultimate correspondence is between 4-digit IO and 4-digit SIC codes, but aggregation is required in both data sets to achieve a one-to-one correspondence. The merged database contains 272 industries at the 4-digit SIC level. The tables below provide details of the aggregation and the final correspondence.

#### Combined IO Codes

To create a complete correspondence, we occasionally need to assign a 6-digit IO code to a different 4-digit IO code for aggregation. For example, in the 1967 IO table, IO codes 170200 (“felt goods, n.e.c.”), 170300 (“lace goods”), 170400 (“padding & upholstery filling”), and so forth are assigned to 4-digit IO code 1710 (“textile goods, n.e.c.”) for final aggregation. This is required because no such industries existed at the 4-digit SIC level.

The tables below report which 6-digit IO codes are assigned to which 4-digit IO codes before aggregating to the 4-digit IO level. This assignment changes for each benchmark IO table.

### **Aggregation**

The values being aggregated are the nominal value of shipments; aggregates are constructed by summing component categories.

### **Combined SIC Codes**

Some SIC codes also require combination. This aggregation occurs mostly at the 3-digit SIC level, which roughly corresponds to the 4-digit IO level, but it is ultimately tailored to preserve the best correspondence with the IO data.

The table below shows which 4-digit SIC codes are combined into a single sector. The combined value of the sectors in the source column is assigned to the SIC code listed in the destination column.

### Aggregation

Three major types of values are aggregated: dollar values (gross output and wages), quantities (number of workers and hours worked), and price indexes. Aggregates for the first two types are simply the sum of values of the component industries.

A price index,  $\pi$ , for aggregated industry  $I$  is the weighted average of the price indexes for the component industries  $i = 1, 2, \dots, N_I$ :

$$\pi_{It} = \sum_{i=1}^{N_I} \omega_{it} \pi_{it},$$

where individual industries are weighted by their share of total shipments

$$\omega_{it} = \frac{V_{it}}{\sum_{j=1}^{N_I} V_{jt}},$$

and  $V_{it}$  is the value of shipments for industry  $i$  in year  $t$ .

### Correspondence between IO and SIC Codes

The table below lists the complete correspondence between 4-digit IO codes and 4-digit SIC codes. The codes used in this table reflect the assignments and combinations described in the previous two sections.
